

HP-UX Introduction

This Introductory course is aimed at those who are completely new to the HP-UX environment or who wish to expand their very basic understanding of the subject.

The course, which lasts for two days, will enable delegates to understand the commands and mechanics of the HP-UX Unix environment, manipulate shell interfaces, use the vi editor, list and manipulate system processes, communicate with other Solaris users, control printing and manipulate file permissions.

Delegates who would benefit from this course are those who are completely new to the HP-UX Unix environment or who wish to expand their very basic understanding of the subject.

Delegates need no HP-UX knowledge, but a general familiarity with computers would be useful.
